Scholarship Program B

The Matamoras Masonic Lodge #374 will award (2) \$500 Scholarships under the guidelines of Scholarship Program B. One \$500 Scholarship will be given to a graduating senior from River High School. The second Scholarship will be awarded to a Frontier High School graduate. For your application to be considered you must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Applicant must be a High School Senior pursuing a Bachelor or Associate Degree at an accredited University, College, Technical or Post Secondary Vocational School. He/She must be a full time student taking 12 semester or 18 quarter hours.**
- 2. The High School GPA of the Applicant must be at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 point scale). A copy of the transcript of high school grades must be sent to the Scholarship Chairperson.**
- 3. The Applicant must take the ACT and receive a score of at least 18.**
- 4. Applicant must turn in 3 letters of recommendation. Letters need to be written by educators, clergy, or other community leaders. The letters need to emphasize the importance of moral character, compassion and respect for others and leadership qualities. Copies of the letters need to be attached with other information sent to the Scholarship Chairperson.**
- 5. Applicant needs to understand that the \$500 scholarship will be awarded in the form of a single payment sent directly to the student after the completion of the first quarter or semester of attending college. The student needs to send the Chairperson a copy of His/Her grades with the proof of receiving a minimum of a 2.0 average before receiving the Scholarship of \$500.**
- 6. The applicant needs to understand that the Scholarship is not renewable and must be initiated within one year of the April 1 deadline.**
- 7. The Scholarship will be based on achievements during grades 9-12 in the following areas: (A) Scholastic Achievements (B) Personal Achievements in school activities such as awards & honors received; Display of Leadership; Membership in different clubs and organizations; sports, music, offices held, plays, etc. (C) Services and Volunteer Work in the church and community (D) Three letters of recommendation need to illustrate the importance of moral character, compassion and respect for others, and displays of leadership in the school, church and community. (E) A 250 word Essay titled " My Biggest Achievement during my high school years" Essay needs to be sent to Chairperson by the April 1 deadline.**
- 8. The Scholarship Committee will determine all qualifications. A committee member will present scholarships to the winners at the Awards Assembly.**
